# tuition break

Through NEBHE's Tuition Break, the Regional Student Program (RSP) students become eligible to pay a lower tuition rate, instead of the regular out-of-state tuition, when they enroll in approved programs at out-of-state public colleges and universities within New England.

A record number of undergraduate and graduate degree and certificate programs are offered through Tuition Break for the 2020-21 academic year – a total of more than 1,200. The approved programs are listed on our website – [nebhe.org/tuitionbreak](http://nebhe.org/tuitionbreak).

## Three ways for students to be eligible under Tuition Break!

- **Specialized degree programs** – Colleges choose to offer their specialized degree programs, that are approved for students if their home-state public colleges do not offer the program.
- **Flexible programs** – Some colleges choose to offer degree or certificate programs under the Flexible policy, which became effective in 2019-20. These programs are approved for residents of all other New England states (*eligibility is not based on the program being unavailable in a student's home state*).
- **Proximity** – Some colleges allow eligibility under the Proximity policy – for students whose home is closer than to an in-state college.
